Dear parents

This being a young adults camp, we want to treat them as such. We do allow the young adults to leave the camp site to do whatever they want (within reason). Examples of the sorts of things we mean are, midnight fishing expeditions, op shopping and coffee shop hopping. Other spare time will be filled just relaxing at the campsite, by playing footy on the oval, or a myriad of other activities in the rec hall. Leaders will attempt to be involved in as many of the activities as possible but at some times the young adults may be unaccompanied by leaders. This sort of unplanned activity, however, brings with it some risks, so we want to outline to the parents, some of the groundrules we will have at camp.

- 1. The 4 study sessions are compulsory.
- 2. Nobody can leave the campgrounds alone.
- When groups leave the campground they must inform a leader, where they are going, who is going, and when they will be back.
- Once at camp, under 18s must only be passangers in cars if the driver is on an open licence.
- All young adults must provide their mobile phone numbers so the leaders can make contact with them at all times.
